The EMRAM **In-Service Review Course** began in 2004 as an annual preparatory course designed for residents to review core topics in Emergency Medicine prior to the in-service exam. The course has been designed as a three-part series....residents are encouraged to attend each of the three years in order to take full advantage of this unique and outstanding opportunity.

The format is designed to address scenario-based questions similar to the in-service and board format of “the next most appropriate action” type question. Speakers are selected for their areas of expertise and teaching ability. Featured speakers represent several residency programs throughout the state. **Attendance has exceeded 250 residents** in the past representing emergency medicine residency programs across the State of Michigan.

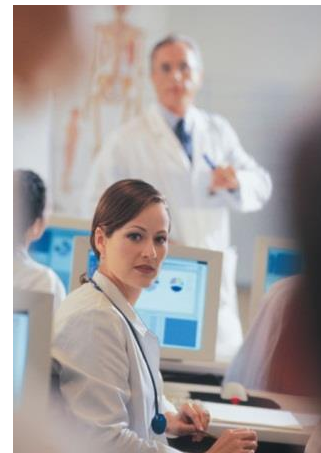


Annual Meeting:
