

What is a tort?


- "A tort is a civil wrong, other than a breach of contract, for which the law provides a remedy"

 - Malpractice






How many survive?

- 16% of lawsuits went to a jury verdict
- 2% of all lawsuits, the jury found for the plaintiff
- 57% of suits resulted in no money being paid out
- 93% resolved before trial (98% in MI)
- In all cases, only 2% had amounts that insurance did not totally cover
 - 1% not covered at all
 - 1% did not cover the whole amount*







More than half of all ER docs will be sued at some point.

- 49.2% of all physicians.
- 51.7% of EM physicians.
 - 72.2% of those over 55.
