Exhibiting at the Assembly

All coffee breaks will be held in the Exhibit Hall to ensure maximum traffic to display areas. Company representatives are encouraged to be present at all sessions and the Opening Reception of the Assembly.

The exhibit area will be open for installation of exhibits on Sunday, July 28 in the afternoon. Exhibitors will be allowed in the Exhibit Hall one-half hour prior to exhibit hours, but *must* depart at the closing hour. Exhibits must be staffed at all times during the exhibit hours. *Schedule subject to final program itinerary.

Dismantling

Exhibitors can dismantle after the last exhibit break on July 30th. The exhibit area must be clear of all materials by 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 30th.

Drawings/Giveaways

Exhibiting companies are permitted and encouraged to conduct prize drawings and distribute giveaways. MCEP staff must be notified of this and will help determine an appropriate time for the winners to be announced.

Hosting of Separate Events

The hosting of separate events, parties, meetings, or other organized gatherings at, as a part of, or in conjunction with any MCEP program without the written permission of MCEP is strictly prohibited.

Opening Reception

Exhibitors are welcome and encouraged to attend the Opening Reception on the Sunday evening that starts off the program.
